








Weather satellites	A satellite that records and collects weather data, such as cloud cover, track storms, such as hurricanes	
radiosondes	Scientists launch weather balloons that carry tools.	
air mass	A large body of air with same temperature and humidity throughout.	
front	The boundary between two air masses.	
cold front	A front where cold air mass bumps into warmer air mass.	
warm front	A front that forms where a warm air mass moves over a cold air mass.

weather forecast	A prediction about the future weather conditions of a place.	
weather map	A map that uses symbols to represent types of weather.	
tropical depression	Forms when a low pressure area is accompanied by thunderstorms that produce a circular wind flow.	
tropical storm	A localized, very intense low-pressure wind system, forming over tropical oceans and with winds of hurricane force.	
hurricane	A storm with violent winds.
