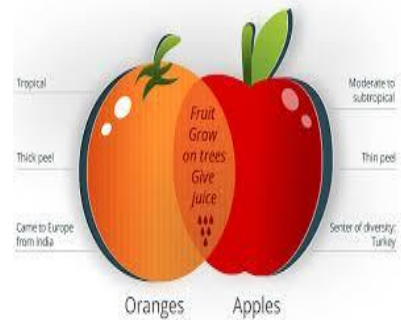
senses

The way you observe and learn (sight, hear, smell, taste and touch)



compare

estimate, measure, or note the similarity or dissimilarity between



sight

You see to observe color, shape, and size



smell

perceive or detect the odor or scent of (something).



taste

the sensation of flavor perceived in the mouth and throat on contact with a substance



hearing

You listen to learn how things sound



touch



You come in contact with something to learn about texture (to feel)



measure

Process of using units that are the same size to determine size, weight, area or volume of something
