






| cirrus clouds | A cloud of a class characterized by thin white filaments or narrow bands and a composition of ice crystals. |  |
| stratus clouds | A cloud of a class characterized by a gray, horizontal layer with a uniform base, found at a lower altitude. |  |
| cumulus clouds | A bulbous or billowing white or dark grey cloud associated with rising air currents. |  |
